DESIGN

Division I: Section A Early Thanksgivings

The following four classes are eligible for the **Designer's Choice** Award. There are four entries in each class. Designer's Choice Award is defined on HB p. 42. It is awarded to the highest scoring exhibit consisting of designs in which the plant material may be dried, treated dried, and/or fresh.

Class 1. Celebration with Thankful Hearts.

Traditional Mass Design (HB p. 71) staged on an 18" cream white pedestal 36" from the floor, placed in front a neutral-color wall. Designer has complete freedom in choice of plant material.

Class 2. European Settlers first occupied Plant City in mid-1800s.

Creative Reflective Design (HB p. 75). To be staged on an 18" cream white pedestal 36" from the floor, placed in front a neutral-color wall. Designer has complete freedom in choice of plant material and Creative Reflective Design. Black underlay cloth to be provided by the committee.

Class 3. Native Americans First Occupied – Ichepucksassa was the original name of Plant City.

Creative Designer's Choice Design (HB p. 72). Designs will be placed on ½ of a 6' table, 30" depth, 30" high covered with a black cloth. Table and cloth to be supplied by GC. Designer has complete freedom in choice of plant material and Design.

Class 4. Thanksgiving celebration with friends using Buffet Tables.

Buffet Tables – service for 4 or more, with components conveniently and logically placed for ease of self-service. At least one (1) serving piece required. Must have a completed flower arrangement. Placement will be on a 6' table 30" wide using black tablecloth supplied by the committee. Exhibitor may substitute a table covering of exhibitor's choice.

Division III: Section A

Educational Exhibits

Eligible for Top Exhibitor Award

The Garden Club and the NGC have a goal to share their members' passion for educating the public on environmental issues. Each competitive exhibit is staged on a 6' wide by 30" table covered in black cloth provided by the committee. Many native wildflowers are blooming in November such as: Gaillardia pulchella (Blanket Flower), Salvia, Spiderwort, Helianthus debilis (Beach Sunflower), and many others.

Exhibit 1 Using native plants to benefit wildlife

Exhibit 2 Wildflowers of Florida
